Registering with Employment Services of Weld County is the first step toward taking advantage of the many resources and services that are available to you at no cost. Registration can be achieved through one of the following methods:

- Coming into our office and using our Resource Room to “self-register” with office staff assistance.

When you have finished your registration, you can begin matching your skills with job openings in our statewide employment database.
