

2018 ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT HIGHLIGHTS

WELD COUNTY, COLORADO

Vestas Blades, Windsor – this wind turbine blade manufacturer completed \$27 million equipment upgrade that will retain 991 jobs and create **100 new jobs**.

Rimrock Energy, Pierce – new \$110 million gas processing facility that will collect, process and transport natural gas. Will be operational mid-2019 and create **20 new jobs**.

Hexcel Corporate, Windsor – this composite material manufacturer and supplier to Vestas is adding a \$20 million second equipment line to increase production capabilities that will **retain 37 jobs and add 50 new jobs**.

Owen Brockway Glass, Windsor – the glass bottle manufacturer is adding \$3.7 million of new equipment to upgrade the manufacturing capabilities. Will **retain 208 jobs**.

URSA Major Technologies, Frederick – this small rocket engine manufacture has expanded into a 10,000-sf building to increase production capabilities. Expansion will **retain 15 jobs and add 5 new jobs**.

RLE Technologies, Severance – this electronic equipment manufacturer is investing \$4 million in a new 15,000 sf building and additional equipment to increase production capabilities. **Relocating 25 jobs and adding 9 new jobs** over several years.

Vestas Nacelles, Brighton – wind turbine nacelle manufacturer is adding second production line to increase capacity that will add **200 new jobs and retain 235 jobs**.

Baselite Building Products, Fort Lupton – this concrete products manufacturer is relocating from Denver and building a new manufacturing campus on 60 acres in Fort Lupton. The operation will **employ 85**, some relocated.

Motherlode Provisions, Hudson – this organic food company has purchased a 40,000-sf existing building in Hudson to further grow their business.

Davinci Signs, Windsor – sign manufacturing company is building new 20,000 sf facility to meet growing production demands that will **retain 35 jobs**.

- Agilent Technologies, Frederick – new 150,000 sf pharmaceutical manufacturing facility announced in 2016 – 170 new jobs
- Leprino Foods, Greeley – 210,000 sf expansion of the cheese processing facility announced in 2016 – 120 new jobs
- Opal Foods, Weld – egg processing facility expansion announced in 2016 – 81 new jobs
- Boulder Scientific – Mead/Del Camino – expansion/remodeling of chemical blending facilities announced in 2016 – 30 new jobs

- Martin Marietta Materials, Weld – new asphalt plant and aggregate trans-load facility announced in 2015 – 100 new jobs
